1	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated XXX from the
2	General Fund for FY2007-08 to the Department of Health and Human
3	Services Finance and Support, for Program 38, to provide one-time
4	infrastructural resources to licensed community-based agencies that
5	have contracts with Regional Behavioral Health Authorities to
6	deliver reform services under Laws 2004, LB 1083. It is the intent
7	of the Legislature that a percentage increase be retroactively
8	allocated to FY2005-06 and FY2006-07 LB 1083 reform services
9	contracts to mitigate infrastructural expenditures and deficits
10	incurred by community-based agencies that have developed and
11	formulated LB 1083 reform services.
12	The Legislature finds that community-based agencies

13 <u>have incurred administrative and infrastructural expenditures and</u> 14 <u>deficits in developing and formulating LB 1083 reform services.</u> 15 <u>Such expenditures and deficits include areas related to information</u> 16 <u>technology, capital construction, and administrative support.</u> 17 <u>An appropriate level of resources for these administrative and</u> 18 <u>infrastructural expenditures and deficits was not included in the</u> 19 original LB 1083 reform services contracts.

20 <u>There is included in the appropriation to this program</u> 21 for FY2007-08 XXX for state aid to provide administrative and 22 infrastructural expenditure relief for licensed community-based 23 organizations, which shall only be used for such purpose.

24 <u>No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and</u>
 25 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
