1 Section 1. Section 28-1206, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 28-1206 (1) Any person who possesses any firearm, knife,
- 4 or brass or iron knuckles and who has previously been convicted
- 5 of a felony or who is a fugitive from justice commits the offense
- 6 of possession of a deadly weapon by a felon or a fugitive from
- 7 justice.
- 8 (2) Such felony conviction may have been had in any
- 9 court in the United States, the several states, territories, or
- 10 possessions, or the District of Columbia.
- 11 (3)(a) Possession of a deadly weapon other than a firearm
- 12 by a felon or a fugitive from justice is a Class IV felony.
- 13 (b) Possession of a deadly weapon which is a firearm by a
- 14 felon or a fugitive from justice is a Class III felony.
