FOR AN ACT relating to the Commission of Industrial Relations; to amend section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change the compensation of members of the commission; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

48-806 As soon as such compensation the same may be legally paid under the Constitution of Nebraska, the compensation of judges each commissioner of the Commission of Industrial Relations shall be two hundred fifty dollars four hundred seventy-five dollars per day for each day's time actually engaged in the performance of the duties of their his or her office. Each judge commissioner shall also be paid his or her necessary traveling expenses incurred while away from his or her place of residence upon business of the commission in accordance with sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.

Sec. 2. Original section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
