Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 789 changes the existing law establishing the Local Civic, Cultural, and Convention Center Financing Act. Under this act, 30 percent of the proceeds of state sales tax diverted for financing projects under the Convention Center Facility Financing Assistance Act may be used to finance local civic and convention centers. The bill raises the amount which can be awarded to cities of various sizes under this act.
