Section 1. Section 13-2705, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 13-2705 The department may conditionally approve grants
4 of assistance from the fund to eligible and competitive applicants
5 within the following limits:

6 (1) A grant request shall be at least twenty thousand
7 dollars but no more than:

8 (a) For a city of the primary class, one million <u>five</u>
9 hundred thousand dollars;

10 (b) For a municipality with a population of forty
11 thousand but less than one hundred thousand, five hundred seven
12 hundred fifty thousand dollars;

13 (c) For a municipality with a population of twenty
14 thousand but less than forty thousand, four <u>five</u> hundred thousand
15 dollars;

16 (d) For a municipality with a population of ten thousand
17 but less than twenty thousand, three <u>four</u> hundred thousand dollars;
18 <u>and</u>

19 (e) For a municipality with a population of five thousand 20 but less than ten thousand, two hundred <u>fifty</u> thousand dollars; and 21 (f) For a municipality with a population of less than 22 five thousand, one hundred thousand dollars;

(2) Assistance from the fund shall not amount to more
than fifty percent of the cost of construction, renovation, or
expansion; and

(3) A municipality shall not be awarded more than one
 grant in any five-year period.
