LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 451

Introduced by Mello, 5.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this study is to examine issues relating to the Small Business Regulatory Flexibility Act proposed by LB 709 in 2010. The bill would have required state agencies to consider the economic impact on small businesses before passing new rules and regulations, would have required agencies to consider less burdensome alternatives, would have set up judicial review of agency compliance with the rulemaking procedures, and would have required state government to periodically review existing rules and regulations to ensure they are not excessive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

- 1. That the Business and Labor Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
- 2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
