LEGISLATIVE BILL 299

FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Safety Center Advisory Council; to amend section 85-1008, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to add a member to the council; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 85-1008, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

85--1008 (1) To assist the center in carrying out its purposes and functions, the Board of Regents may establish a Nebraska Safety Center Advisory Council composed of the following members:

- (a) One representative from the Department of Roads;
- (b) One representative from the Department of Motor Vehicles;
- (c) One representative from the State Department of Education;
- (d) One representative from the Game and Parks Commission;
- (e) One representative from the Department of Labor;
- (f) One person representing the community college areas;
- (g) One person representing private business and industry;
- (h) One person representing the University of Nebraska;
- (i) One person representing the medical profession;
- (j) One person representing the area of law enforcement in this state;
 - (k) One person representing the Safety Council of Nebraska, Inc.;
 - (1) One person representing the area of transportation;
 - (m) One person representative of emergency medical services;
 - (n) One person representing the judiciary in the State of Nebraska;
 - (o) One person representing city government;
 - (p) One person representing county government;
 - (q) One person representing the area of agriculture;
 - (r) One person representing the local public school system;
 - (s) One person representing fire safety;
- (s) (t) One representative of the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education;
 - (t) (u) One person representing the Red Cross; and
 - (u) (v) One person representing the state colleges.
 (2) Representatives selected to serve on the council shall have
- (2) Representatives selected to serve on the council shall have appropriate education, training, and experience in the field of <u>fire safety</u>, industrial safety, recreational safety, domestic safety, or traffic safety.
