Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 110 proposed revision of Section 81-2,162.03 to eliminate a requirement for registering soil conditioner products. Harmonizing deletion of reference to registration is made as necessary elsewhere in the Act. In addition to eliminating reference to product registrations made obsolete by the bill, section 2 amends Section 81-2,162.04 by inserting additional product labeling requirements to include product name and manufacturing source.
