## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 13 attempts to add to Nebraska Statutes the criminal penalty of %u201Clife imprisonment without parole%u201D, in response to the Nebraska Supreme Court%u2019s decision in State v. Conover, which ruled that the criminal penalty of life imprisonment without parole as currently listed in our state statutes, is unconstitutional as the implementation of this bill exceeded the governors call for the 2002%u2019special session during which this act was passed.

This bill is attempting to properly implement the penalty of life imprisonment without parole across the six sections of Nebraska Statutes where this penalty is currently found.
