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Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 265 changes the maximum amount in the petty cash fund under section 81-3120 from one thousand to two thousand dollars. These petty cash funds are created at specific locations at the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to be used for fees and costs related to the prosecution of support establishment, modification, and enforcement cases. The petty cash fund includes the administration of court costs, filing fees, service of process fees, sheriff's costs, garnishment and execution fees, court reporter and transcription costs, and costs related to appeals, witness and expert witness fees, and fees or costs for obtaining necessary document.
