## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 35 increases the maximum renewal period for an overdimensional permit for a vehicle transporting sugar beets, grain, or other seasonally harvested products.

The bill amends Sec. 60-6,298 and the renewal period for a Department of Roads overweight/over length permit so that the maximum renewable period shall not exceed 200 days. Current law allows for a maximum period of 120 days.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendment, AM 512, increases the maximum renewal period to 210 days. This keeps the renewal period in increments of 30 days for ease of the Department of Roads electronic permit system.
