Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 36 provides a process to vote on the fluoridation of the drinking water supply for a city or village that reaches the population of one thousand or more inhabitants after June 1, 2010.

Current law, under Section 71-3305, requires cities and villages of one thousand or more inhabitants to fluoride their drinking water by June 1, 2010. It allowed villages and cities the opportunity to vote, after April 18, 2008 (the effective date of the legislation) and before June 1, 2010, on an ordinance to prohibit the addition of fluoride. LB 36 allows cities and villages who attain one thousand or more inhabitants after June 1, 2010 the ability to vote on fluoridation.
