## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 526 was introduced to enable the transfer of the entire amount of a surface water irrigation right for a nonconsumptive use.

Section-by-section description:

Section 1 amends 46-294, relating to water appropriation transfer applications, by adding an exception to the requirement that such transfer will not exceed the historic consumptive use under the appropriation. The rule does not apply to a transfer of the entire surface water irrigation right for a nonconsumptive use.

Section 2 repeals the original section.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

AM 1784 addresses the concern that allowing a transfer that is a change in preference of use or point of diversion would harm surface water appropriators. The amended language would place conditions on such a transfer, including that the

transfer or change in purpose would not diminish the available water supply or otherwise adversely affect another water appropriator or the state's ability to meet compact obligations, or result in administration of the prior appropriation policy.
