## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 67 clarifies that enforcement of a violation of a child safety seat for children up to age 6 is a primary violation.

The bill amends Sec. 60-6,267 to distinctly separate the provisions dealing with the use of safety belts and restraint systems for children up to age 6 and for children aged 6 to 18.

The bill amends Sec. 60-6,268 to clarify that subsections 2 (children 6 to 18) and 8 (passengers of a provisional operator permit/school permit) are enforced only as a secondary action. This leaves subsection 1 (children up to age 6 in car/booster seats) as a primary violation.
