## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The bill creates the Build Nebraska Act. This act would result in a greater investment in surface transportation infrastructure. This larger investment will be financed with bonded debt. The bill will also dedicate a portion of the state sales tax to financing this investment in surface transportation infrastructure.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

The Committee amended LB 84 to add language to the bill on page 3. This additional language changes the language on use of a 15 million dollar funding amount found in the original bill to read;

"as determined by the department, for construction of the expressway system and federally designated high priority corridors".
