Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 941 would amend 69-206 to require that secondhand jewelry received or purchased under this section must be kept by the pawnbroker, dealer in second hand goods, or junk dealer for 14 days before being eligible for re-sale.

LB 941 would also require that secondhand jewelry shall not be destroyed , damaged, or defaced in any way for 14 days after purchase or receipt by a pawnbroker, dealer in second hand goods, or junk dealer.
