6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 46-2,140, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 46-2,140 (1) The Republican River Basin Water Sustainability Task Force is created. The task force shall consist of 4 5 twenty-two voting members, and except for the state agency 6 representatives, the members shall be residents representing a cross-7 section of the Republican River basin. The Governor shall appoint two 8 representatives from each natural resources district in the basin; four representatives from the irrigation districts in the basin; one 9 representative each from the University of Nebraska Institute of 10 Agriculture and Natural Resources, the Game and Parks Commission, the 11 12 Department of Agriculture, and the Department of Natural Resources; 13 one representative each from a school district, a city, a county, and 14 a public power district in the basin; and two representatives from 15 agriculture-related businesses in the Republican River basin. The 16 chairperson of the Executive Board of the Legislative Council shall appoint four five ex officio, nonvoting members from the Legislature, 17 18 two of whom are residents of the basin, one who has two of whom have a portion of his or her legislative district in the basin, and one 19 20 who is the chairperson of the Natural Resources Committee of the 21 Legislature. For administrative and budgetary purposes only, the task 22 force shall be housed within the Department of Natural Resources. 23 Additional advisory support may be requested from appropriate federal and state agencies. Members of the task force who are not state 24 25 employees shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses

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incurred in carrying out their duties as members as provided in
 sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.

3 (2) The task force shall meet no less than quarterly and 4 shall hire a trained facilitator to conduct its meetings. The 5 purposes of the task force are to define water sustainability for the б Republican River basin, develop and recommend a plan to help reach 7 water sustainability in the basin, and develop and recommend a plan 8 to help avoid a water-short year in the basin. The task force shall 9 convene within thirty days after appointment of the members is completed to elect a chairperson and conduct such other business as 10 11 deemed necessary.

12 (3) The task force shall present a preliminary report to 13 the Governor and the Legislature on or before May 15, 2011, and a 14 final report before May 15, 2012. This section terminates on June 30, 15 2012.

Sec. 2. Original section 46-2,140, Reissue Revised
Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

18 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 19 when passed and approved according to law.

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
