amend section 71-401, Revised Statutes Cumulative
Supplement, 2010; to require general acute hospitals to
offer vaccinations and to require hospital employees to
be vaccinated as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and
to repeal the original section.

- 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Health Care Facility
- 5 Licensure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) Each general acute hospital shall take all of
- 7 the following actions in accordance with the guidelines of the
- 8 <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention of the United States</u>
- 9 Public Health Service of the United States Department of Health and
- 10 <u>Human Services as the quidelines existed on January 1, 2011:</u>
- 11 (a) Annually offer onsite influenza vaccinations to all
- 12 hospital employees when no national vaccine shortage exists; and
- 13 (b) Require all hospital employees to be vaccinated
- 14 against influenza, except that an employee may elect not to be
- 15 <u>vaccinated</u>.
- 16 (2) The hospital shall keep a record of which employees
- 17 receive the annual vaccination against influenza and which employees
- 18 <u>do not receive such vaccination.</u>
