3			for a vote on adding fluoride to the public water supply
4			in certain cities and villages; to harmonize provisions;
5			and to repeal the original section.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-3305, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 71-3305 (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4 (2) or (3) of this section, any city or village having a population 5 of one thousand or more inhabitants shall, no later than June 1, 6 2010, add fluoride to the water supply for human consumption for such 7 city or village as provided in the rules and regulations of the 8 Department of Health and Human Services unless such water supply has sufficient amounts of naturally occurring fluoride as provided in 9 such rules and regulations. 10

11 (2) In any city or village which is required to add 12 fluoride to its water supply under subsection <u>Subsection</u> (1) of this 13 section and in which fluoride is not added to such water supply as of January 1, 2008, does not apply if the voters of the city or village 14 15 may adopt an ordinance, after April 18, 2008, but before June 1, 16 2010, to prohibit the addition of fluoride to such water supply. The ordinance may be placed on the ballot by a majority vote of the 17 18 governing body of the city or village or by initiative pursuant to sections 18-2501 to 18-2538. 19

20 <u>(3) If any city or village reaches a population of one</u> 21 <u>thousand or more inhabitants after June 1, 2010, and is required to</u> 22 <u>add fluoride to its water supply under subsection (1) of this</u> 23 <u>section, the city or village may adopt an ordinance to prohibit the</u> 24 <u>addition of fluoride to such water supply. The ordinance may be</u> 25 <u>placed on the ballot by a majority vote of the governing body of the</u> 1 city or village or by initiative pursuant to sections 18-2501 to 2 18-2538. Such proposed ordinance shall be voted upon at the next 3 statewide general election after the population of the city or 4 village reaches one thousand or more inhabitants.

5 (3) (4) Any rural water district organized under sections 6 46-1001 to 46-1020 that supplies water for human consumption to any 7 city or village which is required to add fluoride to such water 8 supply under this section shall not be responsible for any costs, 9 equipment, testing, or maintenance related to such fluoridation 10 unless such district has agreed with the city or village to assume 11 such responsibilities.
