A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend sections 19, 20, 22, 1 23, and 240, Legislative Bill 374, One Hundred Second 2 Legislature, First Session, 2011; and section 7, 3 Legislative Bill 376, One Hundred Second Legislature, 4 5 First Session, 2011; to appropriate funds to aid in 6 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 390, One Hundred Second Legislature, First Session, 2011; to 7 change appropriations; to provide an operative date; to 8 9 repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency. 10

11 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Original sections 19, 20, 22, 23, and 240, 7 Legislative Bill 374, One Hundred Second Legislature, First Session, 8 2011; and section 7, Legislative Bill 376, One Hundred Second 9 Legislature, First Session, 2011, are repealed. Sec. 9. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 10 11 when passed and approved according to law.
