- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to real property; to change filing provisions
- 2 relating to nonconsensual liens.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) In order that the owner of real property 2 upon which a nonconsensual lien is recorded shall have notice of the lien, an envelope with the name and address of the owner of the real 3 4 property on the envelope, along with the proper postage affixed, 5 shall accompany the nonconsensual lien submitted for recordation at 6 the county recording office. Upon proper submittal and the 7 nonconsensual lien meeting all statutory recording requirements, the 8 county recording office shall record the nonconsensual lien and, using the accompanying envelope, forward a copy of the recorded lien 9 to the owner as addressed on the envelope. If no envelope is 10 submitted with the nonconsensual lien or if the envelope does not 11 12 have the name and address of the owner of the real property on it or 13 the proper postage affixed, the county recording office shall reject 14 the lien. 15 (2) This section does not apply to mortgages, deeds of trust, or any encumbrances in which all parties involved have 16 knowledge of or should have knowledge of the encumbrances. 17 (3) For purposes of this section, a nonconsensual lien is 18 any lien or encumbrance of which the real property owner is not 19 20 aware.
