## A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the Concealed Handgun Permit Act; to amend sections 69-2441 and 69-2443, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change certain penalty and violations provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 69-2441, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 69-2441 (1)(a) A permitholder may carry a concealed 4 handgun anywhere in Nebraska, except any: Police, sheriff, or 5 Nebraska State Patrol station or office; detention facility, prison, or jail; courtroom or building which contains a courtroom; polling 6 7 place during a bona fide election; meeting of the governing body of a 8 county, public school district, municipality, or other political 9 subdivision; meeting of the Legislature or a committee of the Legislature; financial institution; professional or semiprofessional 10 athletic event; building, grounds, vehicle, or sponsored activity or 11 12 athletic event of any public, private, denominational, or parochial 13 elementary, vocational, or secondary school, a private postsecondary career school as defined in section 85-1603, a community college, or 14 15 a public or private college, junior college, or university; place of 16 worship; hospital, emergency room, or trauma center; political rally or fundraiser; establishment having a license issued under the 17 Nebraska Liquor Control Act that derives over one-half of its total 18 19 income from the sale of alcoholic liquor; place where the possession 20 or carrying of a firearm is prohibited by state or federal law; a 21 place or premises where the person, persons, entity, or entities in

control of the property or employer in control of the property has

prohibited permitholders from carrying concealed handguns into or

onto the place or premises; or into or onto any other place or

premises where handguns are prohibited by state law.

1 (b) A financial institution may authorize its security

- 2 personnel to carry concealed handguns in the financial institution
- 3 while on duty so long as each member of the security personnel, as
- 4 authorized, is in compliance with the Concealed Handgun Permit Act
- 5 and possesses a permit to carry a concealed handgun issued pursuant
- 6 to the act.
- 7 (c) A place of worship may authorize its security
- 8 personnel to carry concealed handguns on its property so long as each
- 9 member of the security personnel, as authorized, is in compliance
- 10 with the Concealed Handgun Permit Act and possesses a permit to carry
- 11 a concealed handgun issued pursuant to the act and written notice is
- 12 given to the congregation and, if the property is leased, the
- 13 carrying of concealed handguns on the property does not violate the
- 14 terms of any real property lease agreement between the place of
- 15 worship and the lessor.
- 16 (2) If a person, persons, entity, or entities in control
- 17 of the property or an employer in control of the property prohibits a
- 18 permitholder from carrying a concealed handgun into or onto the place
- 19 or premises and such place or premises are open to the public, a
- 20 permitholder carrying a concealed handgun onto the place or premises
- 21 does not violate this section unless:
- 22 <u>(a) The</u> person, persons, entity, or entities in
- 23 control of the property or employer in control of the property has
- 24 posted conspicuous notice that carrying a concealed handgun is
- 25 prohibited in or on the place or premises and the permitholder

1 entered the place or premises knowing that carrying a concealed

- 2 <u>handgun into or onto the place or premises is prohibited;</u> or
- 3 (b) The person, persons, entity, or entities in control
- 4 of the property or employer in control of the property has made a
- 5 request, directly or through an authorized representative or
- 6 management personnel, that the permitholder remove the concealed
- 7 handgun from the place or premises or, if applicable, secure the
- 8 handgun in a vehicle pursuant to subsection (3) of this section, and
- 9 the permitholder refuses.
- 10 (3) A permitholder carrying a concealed handgun in a
- 11 vehicle or on his or her person while riding in or on a vehicle into
- 12 or onto any parking area, which is open to the public, used by any
- 13 location listed in subdivision (1)(a) of this section, does not
- 14 violate this section if, prior to exiting the vehicle, the handgun is
- 15 locked inside the glove box, trunk, or other compartment of the
- 16 vehicle, a storage box securely attached to the vehicle, or, if the
- 17 vehicle is a motorcycle, a hardened compartment securely attached to
- 18 the motorcycle. This subsection does not apply to any parking area
- 19 used by such location when the carrying of a concealed handgun into
- 20 or onto such parking area is prohibited by federal law.
- 21 (4) An employer may prohibit employees or other persons
- 22 who are permitholders from carrying concealed handguns in vehicles
- 23 owned by the employer.
- 24 (5) A permitholder shall not carry a concealed handgun
- 25 while he or she is consuming alcohol or while the permitholder has

1 remaining in his or her blood, urine, or breath any previously

- 2 consumed alcohol or any controlled substance as defined in section
- 3 28-401. A permitholder does not violate this subsection if the
- 4 controlled substance in his or her blood, urine, or breath was
- 5 lawfully obtained and was taken in therapeutically prescribed
- 6 amounts.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 69-2443, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 8 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 9 69-2443 (1) A permitholder who violates subsection (1) or
- 10 (2) of section 69-2440 or section 69-2441 or section 69-2442 is
- 11 guilty of a Class III misdemeanor for the first violation and a Class
- 12 I misdemeanor for any second or subsequent violation.
- 13 (2) A permitholder who violates subsection (3) of section
- 14 69-2440 is guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.
- 15 (3) A permitholder who violates section 69-2441 is quilty
- 16 of a Class III misdemeanor, except that a permitholder who violates
- 17 <u>subdivision (2)(b) of section 69-2441 is guilty of a Class II</u>
- 18 <u>misdemeanor</u>.
- 19  $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$  A permitholder convicted of a violation described
- 20 in subsection (1), (2), or (3) or (2) of this section may also have
- 21 his or her permit revoked.
