- FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend section 53-1,122, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to compliance checks; and to repeal the original section.

1 Section 1. Section 53-1,122, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 53-1,122 In order to further the public policy of
- 4 deterring minors from illegally obtaining or consuming alcoholic
- 5 liquor, persons under twenty-one years of age may be authorized to
- 6 assist duly authorized law enforcement officers to determine
- 7 compliance with sections 53-180 and 53-180.02. Such compliance checks
- 8 shall be conducted pursuant to guidelines adopted and promulgated by
- 9 the Nebraska State Patrol with input from the commission. <u>Law</u>
- 10 enforcement officers and minors conducting such compliance checks
- 11 shall not consume alcoholic liquor during the course of such
- 12 <u>compliance check.</u> Unless a person is an emancipated minor at least
- 13 eighteen years of age, no person under twenty-one years of age shall
- 14 be authorized to participate or assist law enforcement officers in
- 15 such compliance checks without the written consent of his or her
- 16 parents or legal guardian. A person under twenty-one years of age
- 17 <u>assisting</u> with a compliance check under this section shall be
- 18 truthful about all questions asked by a retailer and when asked if he
- 19 or she is age twenty-one, or old enough to consume alcoholic liquor,
- 20 <u>shall tell the truth about his or her age.</u>
