A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to labor; to require employers to maintain
- 2 employee emergency contact information and notify them if
- 3 the employee is injured.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB 846

1 Section 1. (1) All employers shall maintain current

- 2 <u>emergency contact information for each employee.</u>
- 3 (2) Emergency contact information shall include:
- 4 (a) The current telephone number of the employee's spouse
- 5 or next of kin designated by the employee as his or her primary
- 6 <u>emergency contact person; and</u>
- 7 <u>(b) The current telephone number of another person</u>
- 8 <u>designated by the employee as his or her secondary emergency contact</u>
- 9 person.
- 10 (3) Whenever an employee is injured on the job and the
- 11 injury requires treatment at a medical facility, the employer or an
- 12 <u>employer's representative shall make a reasonable effort to contact</u>
- 13 the employee's primary emergency contact person to notify him or her
- of the injury to the employee immediately after calling 911 emergency
- 15 <u>service or while en route to a medical facility if 911 emergency</u>
- 16 <u>service was not called.</u>
- 17 <u>(4) If the employer or employer's representative is</u>
- 18 unable to contact the primary emergency contact person, the employer
- 19 or employer's representative shall then make a reasonable effort to
- 20 contact the employee's secondary emergency contact person to notify
- 21 <u>him or her of the injury to the employee.</u>
