LB 95

Section 1. Every lead agency contracting with the

Department of Health and Human Services to provide out-of-home care

for children under the age of eighteen years shall be accredited by a

national accrediting entity with respect to the services being

provided by such lead agency. The department may adopt and promulgate

rules and regulations to carry out the requirements of this section.
