## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

To eliminate administrative burdens and create greater efficiencies in the access to public benefit programs by:

- 1. requiring alignment of verification procedures across various public benefit programs to eliminated redundancies;
- 2. maintaining legislative oversight over public benefit administration by requiring the collection and reporting of data relating to access to public benefit programs and case closures.
- 3. coordinating renewals for public benefits by using the longest eligibility period allowable under federal law, renew programs simultaneously, and prevent case closings for reasons other than ineligibility;
- 4. allowing information used to determine eligibility for one public benefit program to be used to determine eligibility for others;
- 5. eliminating asset limits to the extent currently applied to eligibility for benefits under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program;
- 6. broadening acceptable attestations for the purpose of determining eligibility for benefits under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program; and by,
- 7. expanding the use of federal, state, and commercial databases to verify eligibility for public benefit programs;
