The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 28 would reduce paperwork associated with reporting chemigation permit information to the state. By eliminating the requirement that natural resources districts immediately forward copies of approved chemigation permits to the Department of Environmental Quality, the agency and the districts will be able to move towards an electronic reporting system, making the permit process more cost effective and efficient.
