Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB365

Date of Hearing: February 24, 2011

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 365 changes provisions concerning access to information on voter registration applications. The bill adds language prohibiting any person who views the voter's registration application from making notes or memoranda of an applicant's driver license number, the last four digits of a social security number and the voter identification number.

LB 365 requires that a *statewide* voter registration list *with voter history* may be provided by the Secretary of State and establishes a price for this list. The Secretary of State must provide, upon request, a copy of the statewide voter registration list including addresses at no charge to the recognized state political parties. Provision of the list to county party chairpersons is eliminated.
