Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 59 would provide a mechanism for determining the amount of state aid distributed to each of the state's six community college areas for the 2011-12 and 2012-13 fiscal years. State aid for each community college area would equal the amount of aid appropriated by the Legislature for the respective fiscal year multiplied by the following percentage for each community college area:

For the Central Community College Area, eight and eighty-six hundredths percent;

For the Metropolitan Community College Area, twenty-six and fifty-one hundredths percent;

For the Mid-Plains Community College Area, nine and five hundredths percent;

For the Northeast Community College Area, fourteen and four hundredths percent. Of such amount provided for the Northeast Community College Area, one-tenth of one percent shall be provided for Nebraska Indian Community College and two-tenths of one percent for Little Priest Tribal College;

For the Southeast Community College Area, twenty-eight and twenty-seven hundredths percent; and

For the Western Community College Area, thirteen and twenty-seven hundredths percent.

The bill contains the emergency clause.
