The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 61 increases the penalties for unlawful intrusion, which currently is a Class III misdemeanor. Under LB 61, viewing a person without their knowledge in a place of solitude or seclusion would increase to a Class I misdemeanor. If the intrusion is video, audio or electronically recorded, the penalty would increase to a Class IV felony and if it is recorded and distributed, it would increase to a Class III felony.
