1 1. Strike the original section and insert the following 2 new section: 3 Section 1. (1) A person who is a veteran as defined 4 in section 80-401.01 and has been off active duty for two years 5 or less or who is a spouse or dependent of such a veteran who 6 enrolls in a public college or university in this state shall be 7 considered a resident student notwithstanding the provisions of 8 section 85-502 if the person is (a) registered to vote in Nebraska 9 and (b) demonstrates objective evidence of intent to be a resident 10 of Nebraska. 11 (2) A person who is a spouse or dependent of such a 12 veteran and who is younger than eighteen years of age is not 13 required to comply with subdivision (1) (a) of this section until he 14 or she attains eighteen years of age. (3) This section does not apply to a veteran who 15 qualifies for benefits pursuant to 38 U.S.C. 3317, as such section 16 existed on January 1, 2014. This subsection does not affect 17 18 the applicability of this section with respect to the spouse or 19 dependent of such a veteran. 20 (4) For purposes of this section, objective evidence of intent to be a resident of Nebraska includes either a Nebraska 21 22 driver's license or state identification card or a Nebraska motor 23 vehicle registration.
