A person operating a motorcycle shall not carry any 8 other person nor shall any other person ride on a motorcycle unless such motorcycle is designed to carry more than one person, in which 9 10 event a passenger may ride upon the permanent and regular seat, if 11 designed for two persons, or upon another seat firmly attached to 12 the motorcycle to the rear or side of the operator. No person shall 13 operate a motorcycle on a highway in this state with a passenger who is less than forty-eight inches tall unless the passenger is 14 15 sixteen years of age or older. 16 (2) A person shall ride upon a motorcycle only while

16 (2) A person shall ride upon a motorcycle only while 17 sitting astride the seat, facing forward.

18 (3) No person shall operate a motorcycle while carrying
19 any package, bundle, or other article which prevents him or her
20 from keeping both hands on the handlebars.

(4) No operator shall carry any person, nor shall any
person ride, in a position that interferes with the operation or
control of the motorcycle or the view of the operator.
