## (Amendments to E & R amendments, ER162)

## Introduced by Howard

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1 1. Insert the following new section:

2 Sec. 45. To facilitate consistency in training all case managers and allow for Title IV-E reimbursement for case manager 3 4 training under Title IV-E of the federal Social Security Act, as 5 amended, the same program for initial training of case managers 6 shall be utilized for all case managers, whether they are employed 7 by the department or by an organization under contract with the 8 department. The initial training of all case managers shall be 9 provided by the department or one or more organizations under 10 contract with the department. The department shall create a formal 11 system for measuring and evaluating the quality of such training. 12 All case managers shall complete a formal assessment process 13 after initial training to demonstrate competency prior to assuming responsibilities as a case manager. The training curriculum for 14 15 case managers shall include, but not be limited to: (a) An 16 understanding of the benefits of utilizing evidence-based and 17 promising casework practices; (b) the importance of guaranteeing 18 service providers' fidelity to evidence-based and promising 19 casework practices; and (c) a commitment to evidence-based and promising family-centered casework practices that utilize a least 20 21 restrictive approach for children and families.
