## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Authorize issuance of highway construction bonds

## **Explanation of amendments:**

AM 2067 reduces the amount of bonding allowed, from \$400 million to \$200 million. Reduces the time period during which the Highway Commission may issue bonds to two years. Requires that bonds carry a fixed interest rate which may be no higher than 5%.
