Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 161 would amend section 14-415 (Building regulations; enforcement; inspection; violations; penalty), of the Nebraska revised Statutes to provide that the penalty for a violation of a cities, building ordinance will increase the fine from "not less than \$10 and not more than \$100" to a fine of %u201Cnot more than \$500 for each and every day the violations occur.

Explanation of amendments:

AM399 amends LB 161 in the following manner:

Provides that a first and second violation of this act is Class IV(\$100-\$500 fine) misdemeanor and that third and subsequent violations are Class II misdemeanors (6 months/\$1,000/Both), if the third or subsequent violations occur within two years of the prior violation.
