Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends 60-6,279 of the Helmets section of the Nebraska Rules of the Road, to require eye protection by operators of motorcycles or mopeds on highways, to exempt persons over the age of 21 from the helmet requirement, to define eye protection, and to require the words "helmet not required" be printed on the license of those exempt from the helmet requirement.

AM640 becomes the bill. Section 1 amends 60-6,279 of the Helmets section of the Nebraska Rules of the Road to
require eye protection by operators of motorcycles or mopeds on highways, to exempt persons over the age of 21 from
the helmet requirement, and to define eye protection. Section 2 amends 60-6,307, special rules for motorcycles, to
disallow the carrying of passengers under 48 inches tall unless the passenger is 16 years of age or older.
