## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB687 (Christensen), introduced at the request of the State Real Estate Commission, would amend sections 81-885.11, 81-885.13, and 81-885.17 of the Real Estate License Act regarding applications for broker's and salesperson's licenses.

The bill would provide that an application for a broker's or salesperson's license shall expire one year after the date of receipt in the commission's office.

The bill would provide that within thirty days after passing the examination for a broker's or salesperson's license the applicant must complete all requirements for the issuance of a license.

The bill would repeal the requirement that a criminal history record information check shall be completed within ninety days preceding the date the original application for a license or a nonresident license is received in the commission's office. The bill would require that each applicant for a license shall furnish a full set of fingerprints to the Nebraska State Patrol after filing application for a license.
