Summary of purpose and/or changes:  The Rules of the Legislature currently require the Legislative Fiscal Analyst to prepare a fiscal note for each introduced bill prior to its public hearing. LB 871 would extend this requirement to bill drafts. As with the rule, LB 871 would also require state agencies and other entities of government to prepare an agency fiscal note for bill drafts, which would then be reviewed by both the Legislative Fiscal Analyst and the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.		
The fiscal note for the bill draft would be required to be delivered to the requesting senator within 10 days after the request.
