## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 9 would eliminate required transportation for some learning community students.

Section 79-611 would be amended by eliminating required transportation in learning communities for students who attend magnet schools or programs and for open enrollment students who qualify for free or reduced-price lunches, but do not contribute to the socioeconomic diversity of the school building to which the student has transfered.

Section 79-2120 would be amended by removing transportation requirements from the purposes for which the Department of Education certifies the average percentage of students qualifying for free or reduced-price lunches in each school building to learning community member districts.
