Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Currently, on or before July 1 of each year, each agency is required to notify the Legislative Performance Audit Committee of the status of all rules and regulations pending before the agency which have not been adopted and promulgated and, if an appropriation was made with respect to legislation for which rules and regulations are pending to provide funding for or additional staff to implement a program, the status report must include what the funding has been used for and what functions the staff have been performing while such rules and regulations are pending. This language was added in 2011 by LB617.

LB 909 expands this annual notification to require each agency to also provide a listing of all rules and regulations that are in effect and have been in effect for more than five years. In addition, the agency is required to identify the legislative bill, by year of enactment, that required the rules and regulations to be adopted.
