A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to cities and villages; to amend sections 16-317,
2 16-318, 17-605, 17-606, and 19-1101, Reissue Revised
3 Statutes of Nebraska; to change powers and duties of the
4 clerk and treasurer as prescribed; to harmonize
5 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 16-317, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 16-317 The city clerk shall have the custody of all laws
4 and ordinances, and shall keep a correct journal of the proceedings
5 of the council. After ; ~~Provided, that after~~ the period of time
6 specified by the State Records Administrator pursuant to ~~sections~~
7 ~~84-1201 to 84-1220, the Records Management Act,~~ the city clerk may
8 transfer such journal of the proceedings of the council to the State
9 Archives of the Nebraska State Historical Society, for permanent
10 preservation. ~~He shall also keep a record of all outstanding bonds~~
11 ~~against the city, showing the number and amount of each, for and to~~
12 ~~whom said bonds were issued; and when any bonds are purchased, or~~
13 ~~paid, or canceled, said record shall show the fact. In his annual~~
14 ~~report he shall describe particularly the bonds issued and sold~~
15 ~~during the year, and the terms of sale, with every item of expense~~
16 ~~thereof. He or she shall also perform such other duties as may be~~
17 ~~required by the ordinances of the city. He shall also make at the end~~
18 ~~of each month a report showing the amount appropriated to each fund,~~
19 ~~and the whole amount of warrants drawn thereon.~~

20 Sec. 2. Section 16-318, Reissue Revised Statutes of
21 Nebraska, is amended to read:

22 16-318 (1) The treasurer shall be required to give bond
23 or evidence of equivalent insurance of not less than twenty-five
24 thousand dollars, or he or she may be required to give bond in double
25 the sum of money estimated by the city council at any time to be in

1 his or her hands belonging to the city. The treasurer ~~and school~~
2 ~~district, and he or she~~ shall be the custodian of all money belonging
3 to the corporation. The city council shall pay the actual premium of
4 the bond or insurance coverage of such treasurer.

5 (2) The treasurer shall keep a separate account of each
6 fund or appropriation and the debts and credits belonging thereto. He
7 or she shall give every person paying money into the treasury a
8 receipt therefor, specifying date of payment and on what account
9 paid. He or she shall also file copies of such receipts, except tax
10 receipts, with his or her monthly reports, and he or she shall at the
11 end of every month, and as often as may be requested, render an
12 account to the city council, under oath, showing the state of the
13 treasury at the date of such account, the amount of money remaining
14 in each fund and the amount paid therefrom, and the balance of money
15 in the treasury. ~~He or she~~ The treasurer shall also accompany such
16 account with a statement of all receipts and disbursements, together
17 with all warrants redeemed and paid by him or her, which warrants,
18 with all vouchers held by him or her, shall be filed with his or her
19 account in the clerk's office. He or she shall produce and show all
20 funds shown by such report to be on hand, or satisfy the council or
21 its committee that he or she has such funds in his or her custody or
22 under his or her control. If the treasurer fails to render his or her
23 account within twenty days after the end of the month, or by a later
24 date established by the council, the mayor with the consent of the
25 council may consider this failure as cause to remove the treasurer

1 from office.

2 (3) The treasurer shall keep a record of all outstanding
3 bonds against the city, showing the number and amount of each bond,
4 for and to whom the bonds were issued, and the date upon which any
5 bond is purchased, paid, or canceled. He or she shall accompany the
6 annual statement submitted pursuant to section 19-1101 with a
7 description of the bonds issued and sold in that year and the terms
8 of sale, with every item of expense thereof.

9 (4) The treasurer may employ and appoint a delinquent tax
10 collector, who shall be allowed a ~~percent~~percentage upon his or her
11 collections to be fixed by the council, not to exceed the fees
12 allowed by law to the county treasurer for like services. ~~Upon,~~ and
13 ~~upon~~ taxes collected by such delinquent tax collector, the city
14 treasurer shall receive no fees.

15 (5) The ~~city~~ treasurer shall prepare all ~~paving and~~
16 ~~curbing tax~~ special assessment lists and shall collect all ~~paving and~~
17 ~~curbing taxes.~~ special assessments.

18 Sec. 3. Section 17-605, Reissue Revised Statutes of
19 Nebraska, is amended to read:

20 17-605 The city or village clerk shall have the custody
21 of all laws and ordinances, and shall keep a correct journal of the
22 proceedings of the council or board of trustees. After ~~Provided,~~
23 ~~that after~~ the period of time specified by the State Records
24 Administrator pursuant to ~~sections 84-1201 to 84-1220,~~ the Records
25 Management Act, the city or village clerk may transfer such journal

1 of the proceedings of the council or board of trustees to the State
2 Archives of the Nebraska State Historical Society, for permanent
3 preservation. ~~He shall also keep a record of all outstanding bonds~~
4 ~~against the city or village, showing the number and amount of each,~~
5 ~~for and to whom the said bonds were issued, and when any bonds are~~
6 ~~purchased or paid or canceled said record shall show the fact; and in~~
7 ~~his annual report he shall describe particularly the bonds issued and~~
8 ~~sold during the year, and the terms of sale, with every item of~~
9 ~~expense thereof.~~ He or she shall also perform such other duties as
10 may be required by the ordinances of the city.

11 Sec. 4. Section 17-606, Reissue Revised Statutes of
12 Nebraska, is amended to read:

13 17-606 (1) The treasurer of each city and village shall
14 be the custodian of all money belonging to the corporation. He or she
15 shall keep a separate account of each fund or appropriation and the
16 debts and credits belonging thereto. He or she shall give every
17 person paying money into the treasury a receipt therefor, specifying
18 the date of payment and on what account paid. He or she shall also
19 file copies of such receipts with his or her monthly reports, and he
20 or she shall, at the end of every month, and as often as may be
21 required, render an account to the city council or board of trustees,
22 under oath, showing the state of the treasury at the date of such
23 account and the balance of money in the treasury. He or she shall
24 also accompany such accounts with a statement of all receipts and
25 disbursements, together with all warrants redeemed and paid by him or

1 her, which warrants, with any and all vouchers held by him or her,
2 shall be filed with his or her account in the clerk's office. If the
3 treasurer fails to render his or her account within twenty days after
4 the end of the month, or by a later date established by the governing
5 body, the mayor in a city of the second class or the chairperson of
6 the village board with the advice and consent of the trustees may use
7 this failure as cause to remove the treasurer from office.

8 (2) The treasurer shall keep a record of all outstanding
9 bonds against the city or village, showing the number and amount of
10 each bond, for and to whom the bonds were issued, and the date upon
11 which any bond is purchased, paid, or canceled. He or she shall
12 accompany the annual statement submitted pursuant to section 19-1101
13 with a description of the bonds issued and sold in that year and the
14 terms of sale, with every item of expense thereof.

15 Sec. 5. Section 19-1101, Reissue Revised Statutes of
16 Nebraska, is amended to read:

17 19-1101 ~~It shall be the duty of the~~ The treasurer of each
18 ~~village or city having city or village that has a population of not~~
19 ~~more than one hundred thousand~~ to inhabitants shall prepare and
20 publish annually within sixty days ~~following~~ after the close of its
21 municipal fiscal year a statement of the receipts and expenditures ~~by~~
22 of funds of the city or village ~~or city~~ for the preceding fiscal
23 year. The statement shall also include the information required by
24 subsection (3) of section 16-318 or subsection (2) of section 17-606.
25 Not more than the legal rate provided for in section 33-141 shall be

1 charged and paid for such publication.

2 Sec. 6. Original sections 16-317, 16-318, 17-605, 17-606,

3 and 19-1101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
