A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to veterans; to amend section 80-411, Reissue
 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for the waiver
 of fees for dependents of veterans as prescribed; and to
 repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 80-411, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 80-411 (1) The—If the requirements of subsection (2) of
- 4 this section are met, the University of Nebraska, the state colleges,
- 5 and the community colleges shall waive all tuition on behalf of the
- 6 <u>following for</u> a dependent of a veteran:
- 7 <u>(a) All tuition; and pursuant to this section.</u>
- 8 (b) All fees remaining due after subtracting awarded
- 9 federal financial aid grants and state scholarships and grants.
- 10 <u>(2)</u> A person shall be eligible for the waiver <u>of tuition</u>
- 11 <u>and such fees</u> if he or she meets the following requirements:
- 12 (a) He or she is a resident of this state and meets the
- 13 appropriate institution's requirements for establishing residency for
- 14 the purpose of paying instate tuition;
- 15 (b) He or she has a parent, stepparent, or spouse who was
- 16 a member of the armed forces of the United States and who:
- 17 (i) Died of a service-connected disability;
- 18 (ii) Died subsequent to discharge as a result of injury
- 19 or illness sustained while a member of the armed forces which may or
- 20 may not have resulted in total disability;
- 21 (iii) Is permanently and totally disabled as a result of
- 22 military service. Permanent and total disability does not include
- 23 total ratings or other temporary ratings except total ratings based
- on individual unemployability if permanent; or
- 25 (iv) While a member of the armed forces of the United

1 States, is classified as missing in action or as a prisoner of war

- 2 during armed hostilities; and
- 3 (c) If he or she is a child or stepchild of a person
- 4 described in subdivision $\frac{(1)(b)-(2)(b)}{(2)(b)}$ of this section, he or she is
- 5 under the age of twenty-six years unless he or she serves on active
- 6 duty with the armed forces after his or her eighteenth birthday but
- 7 before his or her twenty-sixth birthday, in which case such period
- 8 shall end five years after his or her first discharge or release from
- 9 such duty with the armed forces, but in no event shall such period be
- 10 extended beyond the thirty-first birthday.
- 11 $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$ An application for a waiver shall be submitted
- 12 through one of the recognized veterans organizations or any county
- 13 service officer on a form to be prescribed by the Director of
- 14 Veterans' Affairs. The organization or county service officer shall
- 15 thoroughly investigate to determine if the applicant is eligible for
- 16 the waiver and transmit a recommendation for action on the
- 17 application to the director.
- 18 $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$ If the director determines that the applicant is
- 19 eligible for the waiver, the director shall so certify to the
- 20 institution in which the applicant desires to enroll. The decision of
- 21 the director shall, in the absence of fraud or misrepresentation on
- 22 the part of the applicant, be final and shall be binding upon the
- 23 applicant and upon the institutions specified in this section. The
- 24 director shall adopt and promulgate reasonable rules and regulations
- 25 for the administration of this section.

- 1 $\frac{(4)}{(5)}$ The waiver shall be valid for one degree,
- 2 diploma, or certificate from a community college and one
- 3 baccalaureate degree. Receipt of such degree, diploma, or certificate
- 4 from a community college shall precede receipt of such baccalaureate
- 5 degree.
