13 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2011-12 \$75,000 Cash Funds and for FY2012-13 \$75,000 Cash Funds 14 15 from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund for the purpose of ongoing 16 health-related research and public policy development by the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature. Such funds may be 17 used for, but shall not be limited to, hiring temporary legal 18 19 research assistance, consulting and research contracts, reimbursement 20 for necessary and appropriate expenses incurred in connection with 21 such research and policy development, and actual and necessary travel 22 reimbursement for task forces and committees established to conduct 23 health policy work.
