- FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-155 and 2 60-156, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change the distribution of fees; to repeal the original 3 4 sections; and to declare an emergency. 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-155, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 60-155 (1) For each notation of a lien by a county, the
- 4 fee shall be seven dollars. Two dollars shall be retained by the
- 5 county. Four dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for
- 6 credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. One dollar
- 7 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General
- 8 Fund.
- 9 (2) For each notation of a lien by the department, the
- 10 fee shall be seven dollars. Four dollars shall be remitted to the
- 11 State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash
- 12 <u>Fund. Three dollars</u>, which shall be remitted to the State Treasurer
- 13 for credit to the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund.
