1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$60,000 from

- 2 the Education Innovation Fund and \$1,000,000 from the Early Childhood
- 3 Education Endowment Cash Fund for FY2013-14 and (2) \$160,000 from the
- 4 Education Innovation Fund and \$1,000,000 from the Early Childhood
- 5 Education Endowment Cash Fund for FY2014-15 to the State Department
- 6 of Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions
- 7 <u>of Legislative Bill 495, One Hundred Third Legislature, First</u>
- 8 <u>Session</u>, 2013.
- 9 There is included in the amount shown for this program
- 10 <u>\$10,000 Cash Funds for FY2013-14 and \$10,000 Cash Funds for FY2014-15</u>
- 11 to fund the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for
- 12 <u>Military Children</u>.
- There is included in the amount shown for this program
- 14 \$50,000 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2013-14 and \$150,000
- 15 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2014-15 for early childhood
- 16 <u>education grants pursuant to section 79-1103.</u>
- There is included in the amount shown for this program
- 18 \$1,000,000 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2013-14 and
- 19 \$1,000,000 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2014-15 for the
- 20 Early Childhood Education Grant Program for at-risk children from
- 21 <u>birth to age three.</u>
- 22 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
- 23 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
