Additionally, on October 1, January 1, 11 12 April 1, and July 1 of each year, the department shall report such 13 rates of initial service authorizations, reauthorizations subsequent to initial service authorizations, and denials for behavioral health 14 15 services broken out by the following age groups: Children under the age of 19; adults ages 19 to 64; and adults age 65 and older. The 16 reports required to be submitted to the Appropriations Committee of 17 18 the Legislature by this section shall be submitted electronically.
