5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 46-297, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 46-297 Any person who has an approved, unperfected appropriation pursuant to Chapter 46, article 2, may apply to the 4 5 department for a modification of such permit to include intentional 6 underground water storage associated with the appropriation. The 7 application shall be made on a form prescribed and furnished by the 8 department without cost to the applicant. If the applicant is an individual, the application for a permit shall include the 9 applicant's social security number. Upon receipt of 10 such an 11 application, the department shall proceed in accordance with rules 12 and regulations adopted and promulgated by the department, subject to 13 section 46-226.02.

Sec. 2. Section 46-637, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

46-637 The use of water described in section 46-636 may 16 only be made after securing a permit from the Department of Natural 17 18 Resources for such use. If the applicant is an individual, the 19 application for a permit shall include the applicant's social 20 security number. In approving or disapproving applications for such permits, the Director of Natural Resources shall take into account 21 the effect that such pumping may have on the amount of water in the 22 23 stream and its ability to meet the requirements of appropriators from the stream. This section does not apply to (1) water wells located 24 25 within fifty feet of the bank of a channel of any natural stream

1 which were in existence on July 1, 2000, and (2) replacement water 2 wells as defined in section 46-602 that are located within fifty feet 3 of the banks of a channel of a stream if the water wells being 4 replaced were originally constructed prior to July 1, 2000, and were 5 located within fifty feet of the bank of a channel of any natural 6 stream.

Sec. 3. Original sections 46-297 and 46-637, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
