A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to vital statistics; to amend section 71-615,
2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to change
3 annulment and dissolution of marriage reporting
4 requirements; and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 71-615, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

3 71-615 On or before the fifth day of each month, the
4 clerk of the district court of each county shall make and return to
5 the department, upon suitable forms furnished by the department, a
6 statement of each action for annulment or dissolution of marriage
7 granted in the court of which he or she is clerk during the preceding
8 calendar month. The information requested by the department shall be
9 furnished by the plaintiff or his or her legal representative and
10 presented to the clerk of the court, ~~with the complaint.~~ The
11 information requested by the department shall include information
12 regarding the legal custody, physical custody, and parenting time
13 determinations for each child, if any, who is affected by the action.
14 If, after reasonable attempts are made by the plaintiff or his or her
15 legal representative to attain such information, the information is
16 unavailable, the designation unknown shall be accepted by the
17 department. If no annulments or dissolutions of marriage were granted
18 in the county during the preceding month, a card furnished by the
19 department indicating such information shall be submitted on or
20 before the fifth day of each month to the department.
