- 3 53-180.06 (1) To establish proof of age for the purpose
- 4 of purchasing or consuming alcoholic liquor, a person shall present
- 5 or display only a valid driver's or operator's license, Nebraska
- 6 state identification card, military identification card, alien
- 7 registration card, or passport.
- 8 (2) Every holder of a retail license may maintain, in a
- 9 separate book, a record of each person who has furnished documentary
- 10 proof of age for the purpose of making any purchase of alcoholic
- 11 liquor. The record shall show the name and address of the purchaser,
- 12 the date of the purchase, and a description of the identification
- 13 used and shall be signed by the purchaser.
