Section 1. Notwithstanding section 44-3,131, (1) any 1 2 individual or group sickness and accident insurance policy, 3 certificate, or subscriber contract delivered, issued for delivery, 4 or renewed in this state and any hospital, medical, or surgical 5 expense-incurred policy, except for policies that provide coverage 6 for a specified disease or other limited-benefit coverage, and (2) 7 any self-funded employee benefit plan to the extent not preempted by 8 federal law shall provide coverage for the provision of amino acid-9 based formulas for the treatment of an eosinophilic disorder or short bowel syndrome. Such coverage shall be provided to any patient born 10 11 on or after January 1, 2012, who is less than five years of age and 12 whose prescribing physician has issued a written order stating that 13 the formula is medically necessary and is the sole or primary source 14 of nutrition for the patient.
